Re: Termination of Drought Stage1

Current Aquifer Index levels are above drought trigger stage of 1410 feet above mean sea level to 1412.6 feet. The Palmer Drought Severity Index is now stated to be "Near Normal" -1.9 to + 1.9 yielding a drought triggering point of "0". The Guadalupe River remains above drought trigger stage.

These conditions have existed for more than seven days. **All drought stages are terminated as of this notice.** The Headwaters Groundwater Conservation District ask for the support of all water users in Kerr County to continue the best conservation practices possible. After two years of drought the aquifer levels are far from recovering to 2007 levels.
